

3. Learners with EMA by Age Band and Section

- This table shows the number of learners by Age and Section for 2008/09 and 2009/10, analysed by Educational Maintenance Allowance (EMA) status.
- Educational Maintenance Allowances were introduced to encourage 16-18 year olds to attend full time learning. It is an income-based allowance.
- For both years, there is a significant proportion of KCC learners who are eligible for EMA payments. During 2010/11 it was estimated as being approximately 75% of 16-18 year old learners.
